1886 Blend

GREAT EXHIBITION

This historical blend is inspired by the type of tea enjoyed in Victorian London when Walter Whittard opened his first shop in 1886 – malty, full-bodied and full of flavour. This was Victorian London in its heyday, after the Great Exhibition had established Great Britain as a dazzling player on the world stage. If you enjoy a classic English cup of tea with a rich, gutsy flavour, this is the blend for you.

Rosebuds

KEW GARDENS

This unusual infusion is crafted solely from whole pink rosebuds, giving a sweet, rounded taste and a gently refreshing finish. We've chosen it to represent the botanical paradise of Kew Gardens, a home for plants and trees from around the world which plays a vital role in their study and conservation.
